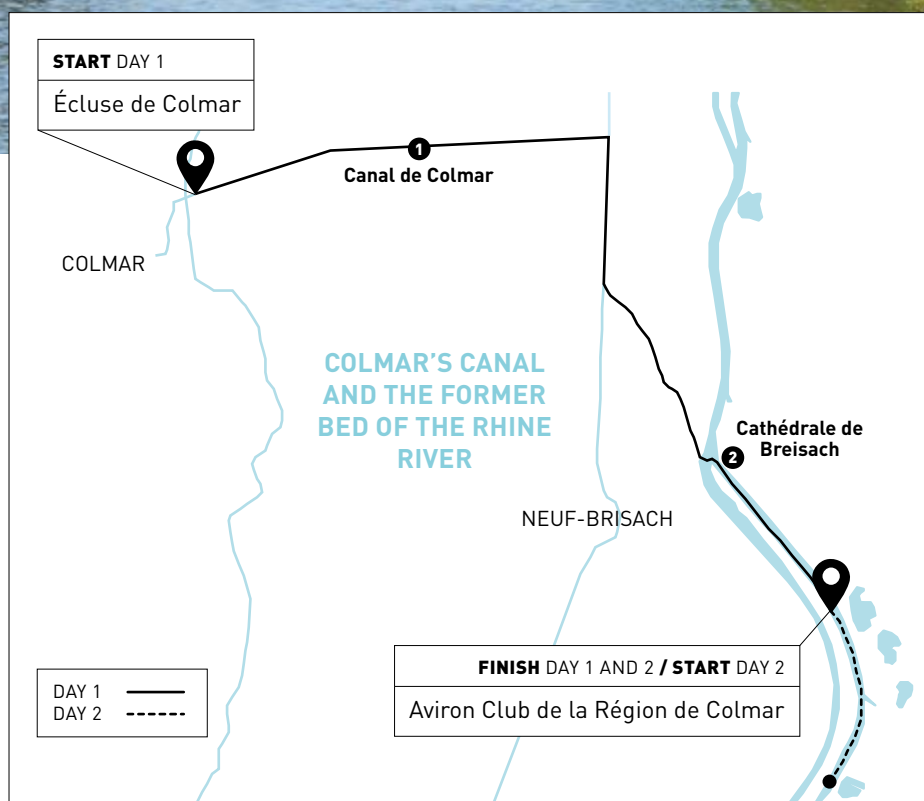

PROVISIONAL PLANNING

DAY 1

1 PM Start of the 28-km tour at the Ill lock, navigation on the Colmar canal towards the Rhine with the crossing of three locks and rowing up the Old Rhine.

6 PM Arrival, festive dinner at the Geiskopf nautical base.

DAY 2

9 AM Boat launching, a 16-km trip rowing up the Old Rhine along the French bank, U-turn and rowing down the Old Rhine along the German bank.

1 PM Arrival, country-style buffet at the nautical base.

For the accommodation, participants will be offered special rates agreed upon with partner hotels.

For the accompanying persons, mountain biking along the rivers, supervised by the club members.
